Inter-Company Karting Challenge Entry rules

Background

The Lotus Inter Company Karting Challenge (ICKC) started back in 2002 as a way for Lotus employees past and present to reunite and catch up with old colleges and for friends of Lotus (suppliers, clients...) to have a fun, sociable event.

We usually get a full grid, sometimes having to turn teams down. So we decided to give priority to company teams by adding some entry rules. This will help ensure the event is fun, tightly contested and as its name suggests Company based.

Entry Rules

1. Each team consist of between 2-5 drivers.
2. The team must have at least half of its drivers related* to the same company.
3. A team of 2 drivers both have to be related* to the same company/club.
4. Driver names and company e-mail addresses should be provided for each driver upon entry.
5. Team name to be supplied upon entry.
6. The team name has to contain the company/club name (or give a good hint).
7. Each driver must have driven a kart before, either 2 or 4 Stroke.

***Definition of related:**

- Work or have worked for the same company (contractors allowed)
- Current members of a Lotus club (SELOC, Lotus on Track, LMC)
- Current members of a non-Lotus enthusiasts club (contact us)

We hope you find these entry rules in the intended spirit of the Lotus ICKC.
